Pamer"s laboratory investigates innate and adaptive immune responses to infection by microbes, with a particular focus on the role of the intestinal microbiota and the mucosal immune system in preventing infections by antibiotic—resistant bacterial pathogens. We study the role of specific commensal bacterial species in providing resistance against Vancomycin—resistant Enterococcus, highly antibiotic—resistant Klebsiella pneumoniae and Clostridium difficile.
